

## Damai CCA Policy

- $\succ$  CCA is <u>compulsory</u>
- Most CCAs are conducted on either <u>Mondays</u> and/or <u>Thursdays</u>. (Extra training during peak seasons on Wednesday)
- Students who miss CCA miss out on an integral part of the school experience where strong friendships are forged and character is built
- Students will be at a disadvantage when it comes to post-secondary course selection





- You may re-submit anytime within the selection period. Only the latest submission will be considered.
- You will need your **<u>NRIC number</u>** to login

1. You must choose at least one Uniformed Group (UG) in your top 6 CCA choices

2. Do not select CCA that are gender specific if you are of the opposite gender. i.e. Girls should not select Rugby (boys only). These choices will be deemed invalid.
