We are writing to inform that your child/ward will be participating in an ALP-Geography Learning Journey to Pasir Ris Park Mangroves on 26 March 2024 (Tuesday).

Pasir Ris Park Mangroves is a unique mangrove forest that is rich in biodiversity and an important site for migratory birds and other wildlife. During the learning journey, students will learn about the structure and adaptations of these forests, the value of these forests as well as observe birds, wildlife and the flora in the mangroves. Through this learning journey, we hope that students will appreciate the importance of conserving these disappearing forests in Singapore and develop a sense of commitment and ownership of the parks and greenery. This is aligned to the Lower Secondary Social Studies and our school's ALP theme on Sustainability.
