We are writing to inform that your child/ward will be participating in a History Learning Journey to the Civic District for students taking G3 History.

The Civic District is the historic birthplace of Modern Singapore as planned by Sir Stamford Raffles in 1822 to lay the foundation of a thriving trade post. During this Learning Journey, students will visit 9 National Monuments in the Civic District area, where they will solve puzzles at each location and learn about the historical significance of each monument. The Learning Journey will be led by trained docents from the National Heritage Board. Through this learning journey, we hope that students will gain deeper historical knowledge of how far Singapore has come from its humble beginning as a fishing village to a metropolis today, as well as appreciate and be grateful for all that the early settlers had done to contribute to the flourishing Singapore we have today.

As this is a school-sponsored activity, absence from this activity will be excused if students are unwell, covered with a Medical Certificate or government-issued endemic management measure.
